



Tonto Rim Christian Camp – COVID-19: Coronavirus Update

Tonto Rim Christian Camp is deeply committed to the health and safety of all our guests and staff!

In recent weeks, there has been a lot of news coverage regarding the coronavirus (COVID-19). Please know that our leadership is aware of the issues and concerns, and is in touch with local health officials! We continue to have procedures in place that will mitigate any potential impact on our guests—with thorough camp-wide cleaning and disinfecting, providing sanitizer stations, requesting any guests showing symptoms not come to camp, monitoring guests while on-site, and isolating sick guests (with removal from camp as quickly as possible).

To date, we have had no detected incidents of coronavirus with our guests, churches, or local community. In fact, we have not had any known spread of illness this season at camp! Thanks to God for this!

In the event of an outbreak affecting TRCC, we will follow directions as needed from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)—as well as state and local agencies—up to and including quarantines of guests, staff or staff families, and will comply with camp closure if mandated. We will continue to track the status of communicable diseases, use best practices to reduce the impact of these diseases, and communicate any potential impacts to our guests and staff.

Additionally, we would like to inform you of steps you can take to protect yourself from illness. Based upon advice from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC):

- **Wash your hands frequently** with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- **Use hand sanitizer (with at least 60% alcohol content).**
- **Do not touch your face.**
- **Clean and disinfect items and surfaces** that you touch frequently.
- **Cover your coughs and sneezes** – with tissues, your elbow, or clothing – not your hands.
- **Use verbal salutations** instead of handshakes.

The Centers for Disease Control and World Health Organization can each provide additional resources for you.

Please know that our team is taking this seriously and we are monitoring this situation closely. We will continue to do what we can to protect you—and we appreciate your partnership in doing what you can do to keep safe and healthy. **Please do not come to camp if you have a fever, cough, or any flu-like symptoms! Any campers found not to be in good health will be sent home.** Sick campers sent home who do not spend any nights will be refunded 100% of their registration fees. Additionally, TRCC is glad to be flexible with our guest leaders regarding their contracted minimums during this season.
