



2021 Spring/Summer Covid-19 Protocols at TRCC!

TRCC is open and ready to serve you this spring & summer! To date, we have not been traced to one case of Covid-19 at camp. We thank God for this, and we want to work together with you to continue providing the safest camp experience possible.

What TRCC Will Do to Help Keep Guests Safe

In General

- TRCC is operating at reduced occupancy in an effort to provide you the opportunity for safer, social distancing.
- TRCC has intensified its cleaning and sanitizing processes, including the use of state-of-the-art electrostatic disinfecting spray equipment along with cleaners that kill the Covid-19 virus on surfaces in less than one minute.
- Hand sanitizing stations and sprays are now provided throughout the camp and are available in every building.

TRCC Staff

- Staff health monitoring, including weekly health surveys and daily temperature checks, is standard protocol.
- All staff will be wearing masks when less than 6 feet from guests.

The Dining Experience

- Food Service Staff will always wear masks when preparing and serving your meals.
- Guests will be reminded to wear masks when entering and moving about the dining hall.
- Guests will be reminded to use hand sanitizer upon entry to the dining hall and at all food service locations.
- Some food service items, such as condiments, are individually wrapped to prevent the spread of germs.
- The Dining Hall will be closed for cleaning and sanitizing for up to 90 minutes following each meal.

Meeting Rooms & Public Restrooms

- Meeting rooms and public restrooms will be deep cleaned and sanitized prior to your arrival.
- Meeting rooms and public restrooms are sanitized twice daily.

Guest Cabins

- Cabins will be deep cleaned and sanitized prior to your arrival.
- Fans will be available in every cabin in order to maximize ventilation.

Recreational Opportunities

- TRCC is offering a full slate of recreational activities, from Zip Line to Lake Trips!
- TRCC-run rec will include enhanced cleaning techniques and the wearing of masks for some activities.
- Equipment sanitizer will be available at all "general rec" locations for your use. Staff will also sanitize equipment twice daily.

What TRCC Guests Will Be Asked to Do

Pre-camp Health Survey

- Guests will be required to complete a health survey just prior to their arrival at camp, including two questions about exposure to COVID and any symptoms, along with the reporting of temperatures.
- Each person's temperature will be taken again by a TRCC staff member upon arrival at camp, and any person with a fever of 100 degrees or more will not be allowed to check in.

Practice Great Hygiene

- Guests will be encouraged to engage in hand washing regularly and to make use of hand sanitizer often.

Mask Requirements

- All guests will be required to wear masks when entering and moving about the dining hall.
- All guests will be required to wear masks at certain TRCC-run events such as the Zip Line.
